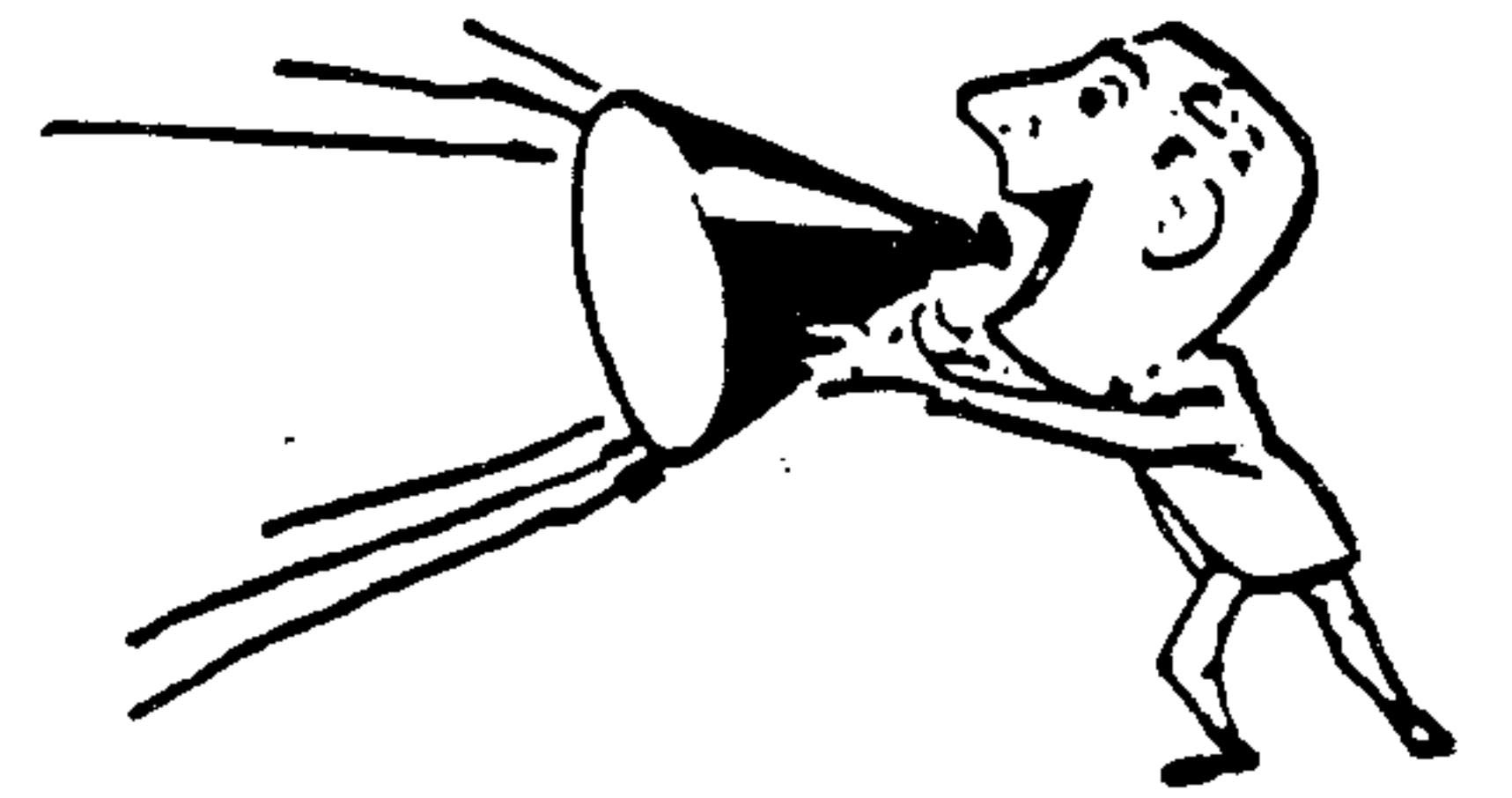
We especially invite El Capitan's first graduation class of 1960 - please pass this information around.
