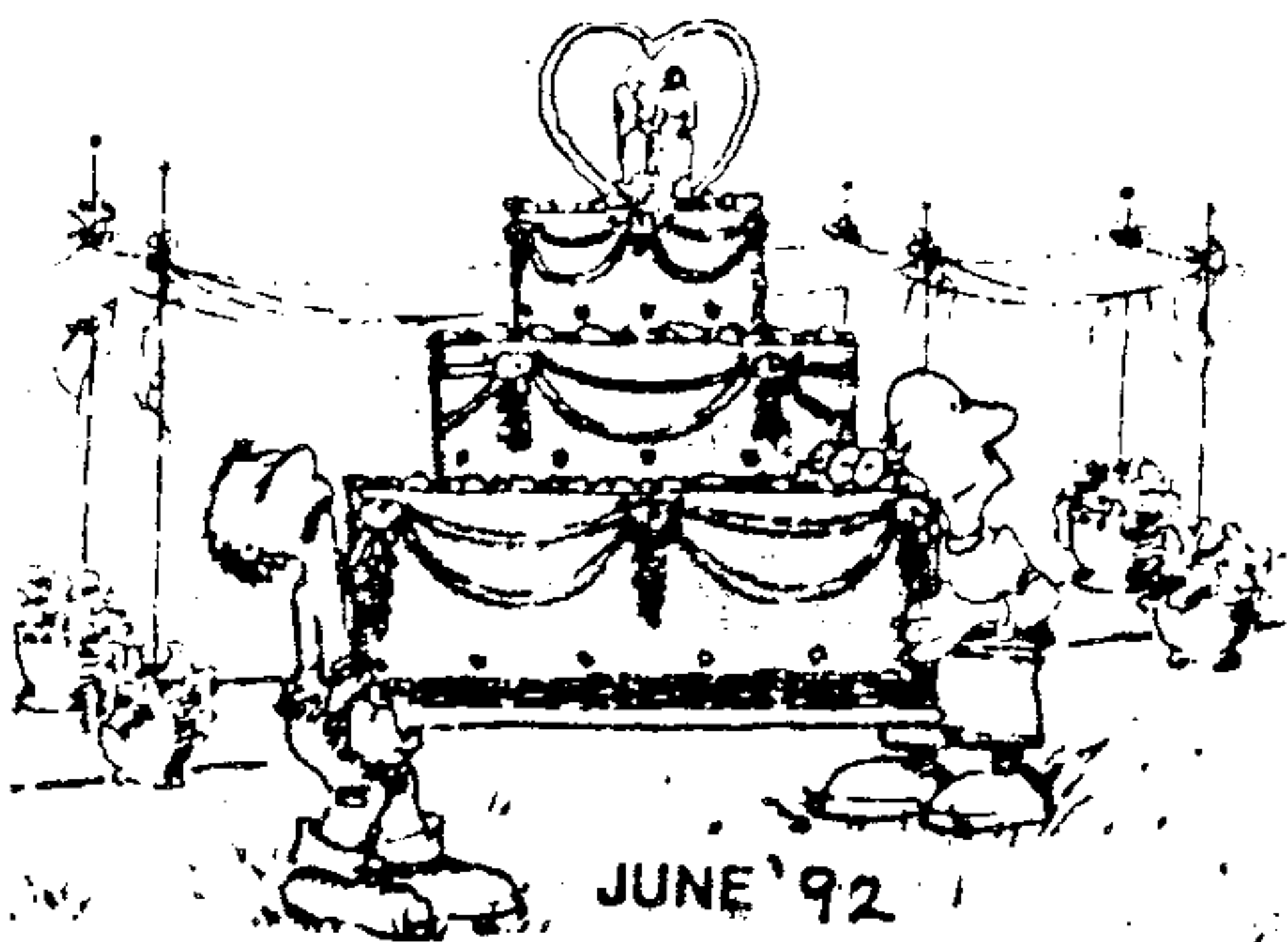

Fish tales

LAKESIDE — Jennifer Fite isn't likely to let her father, Larry, soon forget who the real fisherman in the family is.

One of 585 anglers visiting San Vicente last week, Jennifer, 10, of San Diego, came away with the second-largest trout reported when she landed a 4-0 rainbow while trolling a Rapala near the dam. Larry, meanwhile, settled for a 3-3.

In four days of fishing at the reservoir, rangers checked 782 bluegill, 173 bass, 61 rainbows and six channel cats.

Gilbert and Alda Spaulding of Chula Vista used black plastic worms at the Toll Road for four bass weighing 19-4. Alda took top honors with an 8-2, while Gilbert checked a 6-0 bass.

Thom Turner of Corona used a green plastic worm at the island for a 7-14 bass, while El Cajon's Dale Bolokowsky trolled Needlefish for a 16-2 limit of trout topped by a 4-4.

San Vicente is open Thursday through Sunday. (mkm)

In three days of fishing at El Capitan, 759 anglers checked 800 bluegill, 441 crappie, 43 bass, 34 blue and 30 channel catfish. Dennis Rupe of Lakeside baited a crawdad for a 9-2 bass, while Sonny Ruis of El Cajon took an 8-8 bass (released) on a shiner. Kristina and Al LeClair of Jamul also used shiners for 38 crappie totaling 22-8, topped by a 1-6. El Capitan is open Friday through

Sunday ... Lake Jennings continues to be the county's hot spot for trout, with 817 anglers last week checking 1,068 rainbows (153 limits). The remainder of the creel included 67 bass and 62 catfish. Six-year-old Bubba McArthur of Lakeside took a 6-3 trout on a nightcrawler, while El Cajon's Bill George used a Rapala for a 4-4 trout. Lake Jennings is open Friday through Sunday.

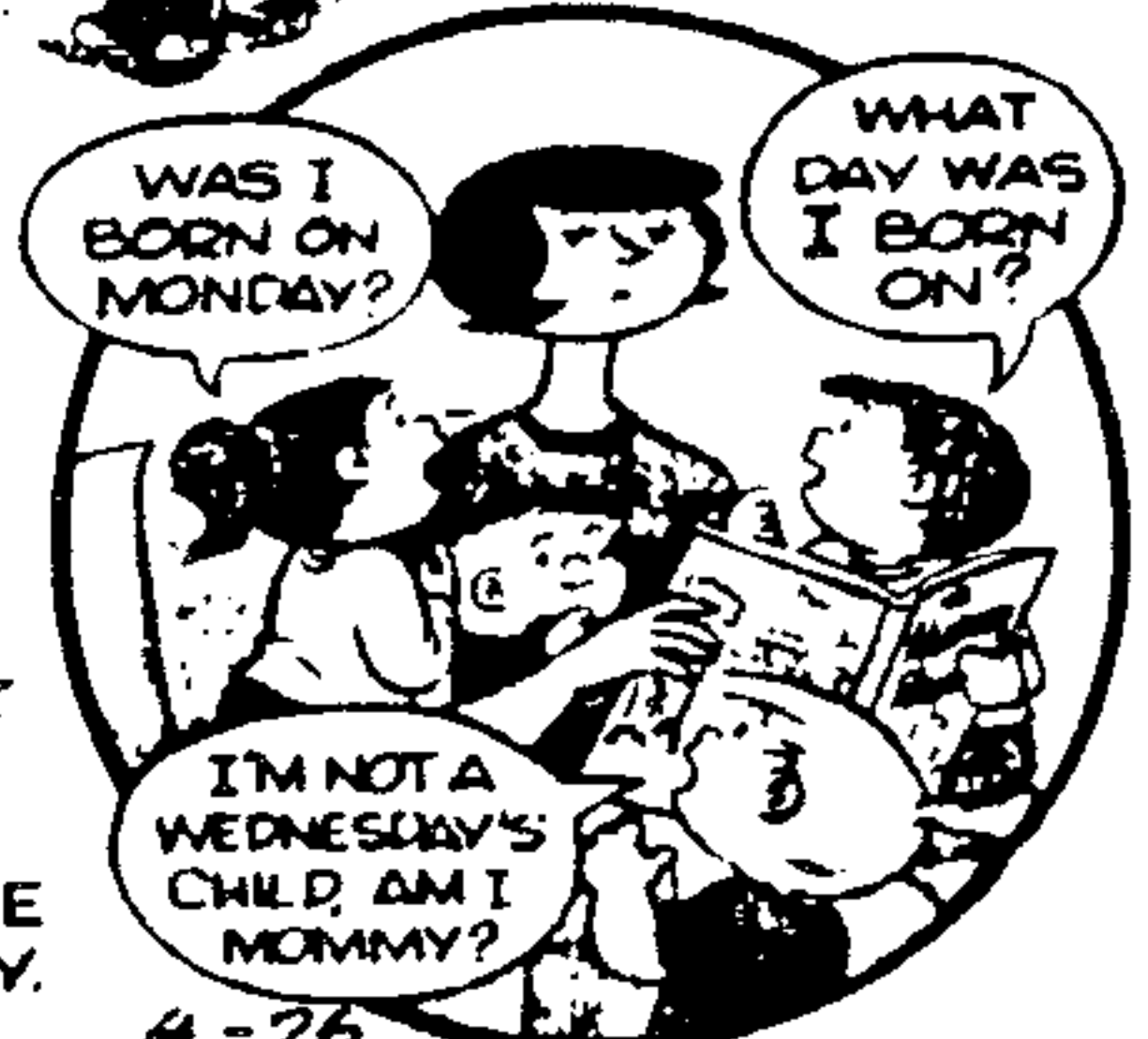

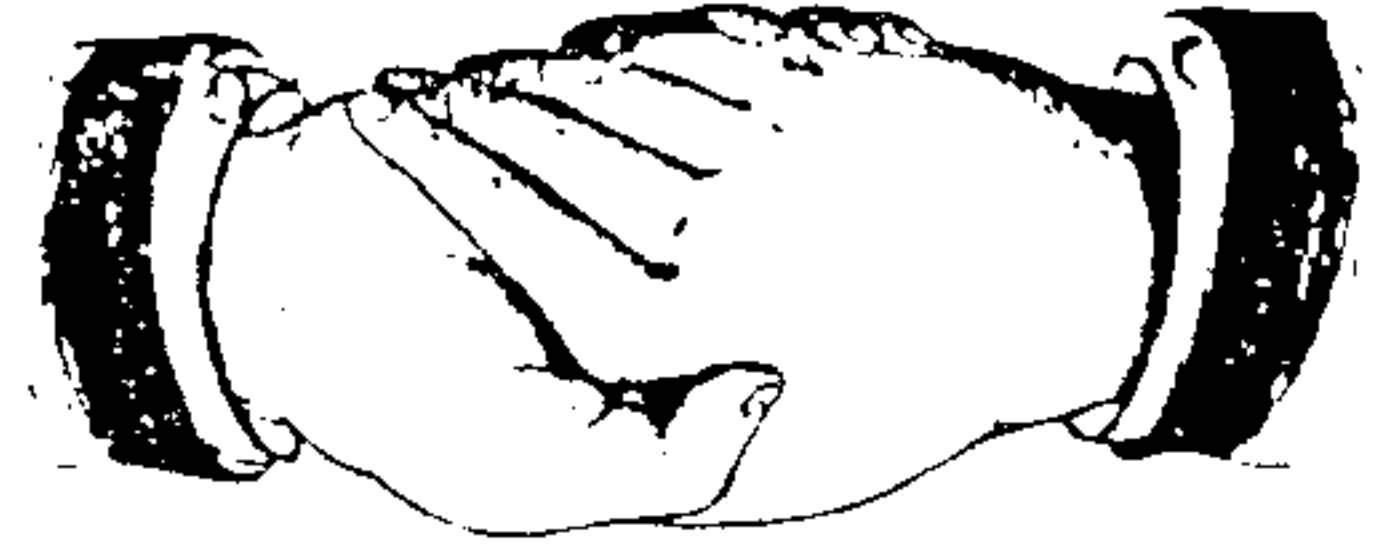

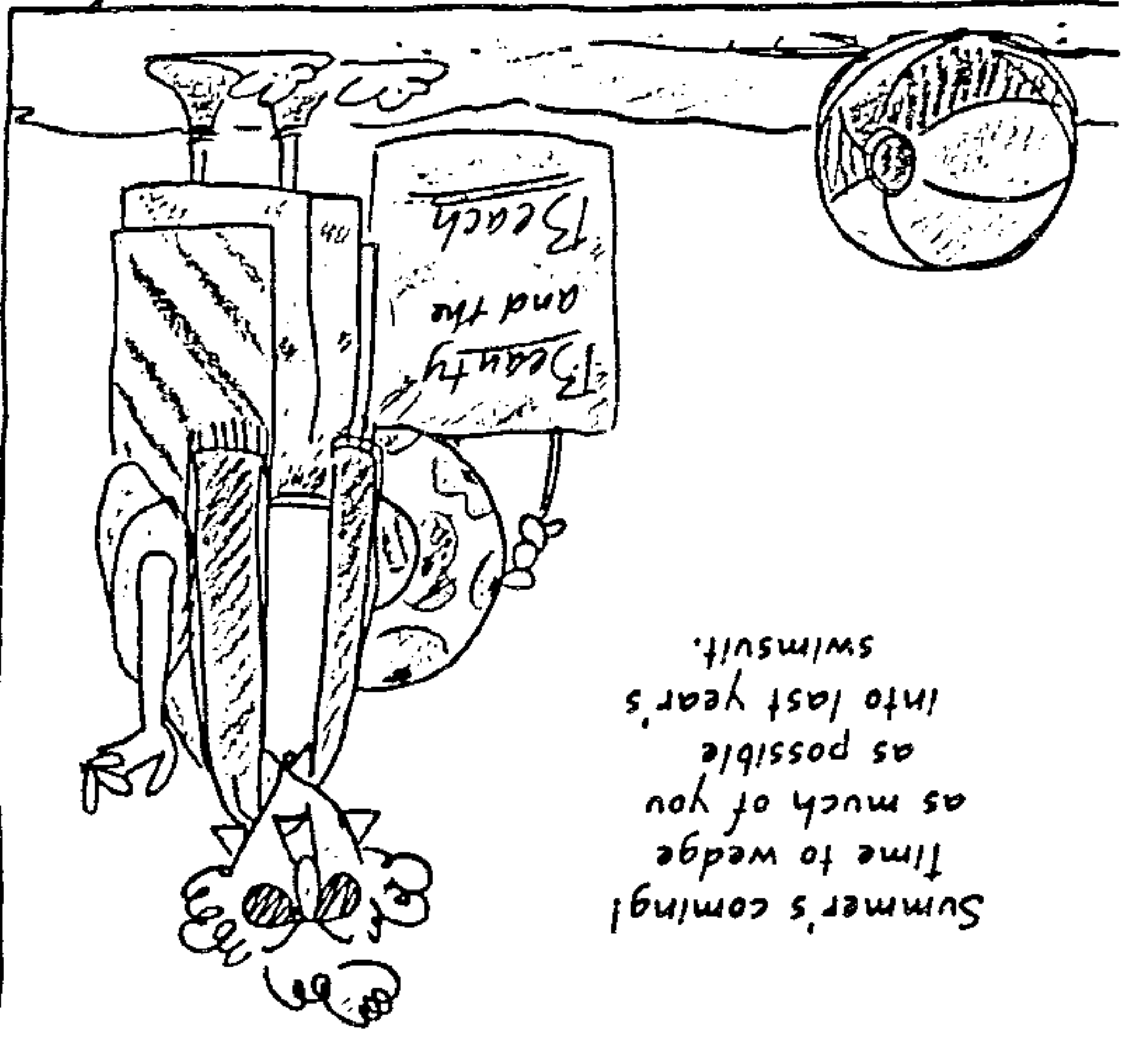
