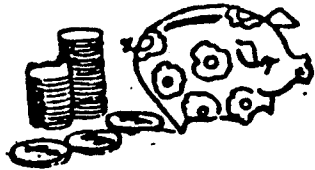
# TREASURERS REPORT by Elaine Brack

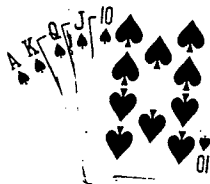

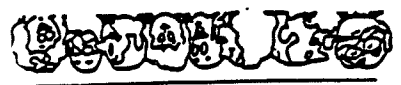

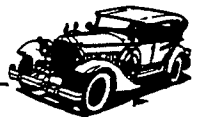
