Due to rain

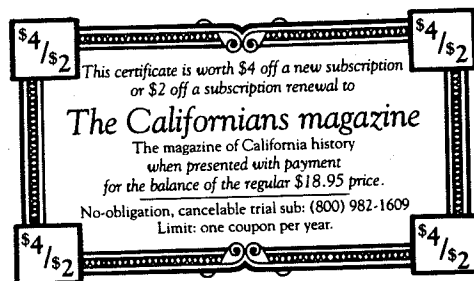
