"East of San Diego" tells the story of the police department of the former City of East San Diego. In 1912, C.W. Justice (no relation to Buford T.) was named ESD's first police chief of the small town with local prohibition and occasional moonshiners. In June 1919, the first bank robbery in San Diego County occurred in ESD. \$10,900 (\$163,000 in current dollars) was taken. Unfortunately, no police car was immediately available so the robbers escaped.
